MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

CERTIFIED MEMBER

Shall be a Certified Athletic Trainer and shall be entitled to vote and hold office.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

- A. Persons applying for Associate Membership are individuals who are pursuing the profession of Athletic Training.
- B. Qualifications for Membership:
 - 1. Have a Bachelor’s or advanced degree from an accredited college or university.
 - 2. Currently making progress toward the fulfillment of the requirements for the NATA Certification under a.and/or b. as follows:
 - a. Enrollment in one or more academic courses, in an accredited college or university, that are related to the fulfillment of the requirements for NATA Certification.
 - b. Currently acquiring acceptable supervised athletic training work hours under the supervision of a NATA Certified Athletic Trainer. Such hours must conform to the description of the character of supervised work hours indicated in the requirements for Certification as currently promulgated by the National Athletic Trainers Association, Inc.
 - c. This class of membership is open to those persons with Association membership in the NATA, Inc.

C. Associate members are eligible to serve on committees but are not eligible to vote on society affairs.

RETIRED MEMBER

A. A Certified Member who retires may apply for this class of membership which, at the time of the adoption of these By-Laws, shall be a class without the requirements of payment of dues, although subject to possible future dues if so declared by the Board of Directors. These members may vote and serve on committees, but shall not be eligible to hold elected office.

STUDENT MEMBER

A. This category of membership shall be open only to full-time graduate or undergraduate college students who are preparing to become athletic trainers and who are not already certified athletic trainers. This class of membership shall have no vote.

ADVISORY MEMBER

A. This class of membership shall be available to those physicians and other professionals who practice in the field of sports medicine and who are directly associated with a sports program which is providing health care and advice to members of a team in association with an athletic trainer.

B. The recommendation for membership shall be made only by a Certified Member. Such candidate does not need to be a member of the National Athletic Trainers Association, Inc.

C. Although not entitled to vote, such members may serve on committees of this Society.

HONORARY MEMBER

A. This class of membership shall be available to those persons who demonstrate profound interest in the athletic training profession and in enhancing its services to those athletics.

B. Nominations for this class shall be made only by Certified Members to the Chair of the Honors and Awards Committee, who shall then submit the candidate's name to the Board of Directors with his/her recommendation. This member is entitled neither to vote nor hold office, but may serve on committee.

AFFILIATE MEMBER

A. This class is available to individuals who are interested in the relationship of athletic training to education, biological sciences, psychology, athletics, sports medicine or physical therapy. A person applying for membership in this class need not be actively engaged in or directly related to athletic training. This individual must be recommended for membership by a Certified Member of the Society.

B. A candidate for this class of membership shall have a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, and be professionally working in education, athletics, research or medicine.

C. A physician who is a team physician should be a Society member in the ADVISORY class.

D. Membership in this class does not count as time preparatory to certification or as a matter of records for time engaged in the Athletic Training profession.

E. Affiliate members are not entitled to vote on Society affairs or to serve on Society committees.

CERTIFIED STUDENT MEMBER

A. This category shall be open to full-time graduate students who hold NATABOC Certification. This class of membership shall be eligible to vote on Society affairs.
