

County Delegates are extensions of the Regional Representative and the Board of Directors and therefore, must adhere to the PATS mission. Regional representatives shall appoint County Delegates with final approval of the Board of Directors. The term of this position is three year term that coincides with the regional representative's elected term but the County Delegates may serve one additional term if the regional representative asks them to continue, until they resign, or they are replaced. The County Delegate may not hold a board of director's or chair's position simultaneously. To serve in this position, one must work/live within the county for which they serve.

The specific duties of this position are:

- Act as a conduit between the Regional Representative and the county in which they work/live (as an athletic trainer (AT)).
- Collect demographic and work setting information of the athletic training positions in their region
- Maintain a list of secondary schools and colleges that do not have AT coverage and assist Regional Representatives with the education of school districts about the benefits of employing an athletic trainer
- Recruit AT in the county who are non-members and provide them with information on the benefits of PATS membership and the opportunity to join PATS
- Organize county networking and social opportunities for ATs in collaboration with the PATS regional representative
- Mentoring AT's new to the county
- Notify the Regional Representative new events/PR efforts/CEU opportunities within the County
- Establish and maintain relationships with local politicians

* If a county does not have a county representative, the regional representative will act as the county representative until one can be appointed.
